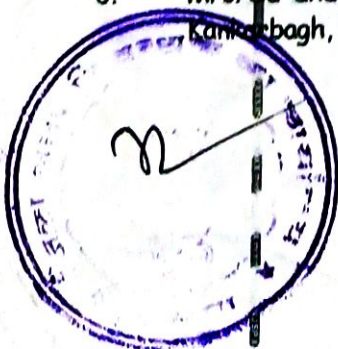

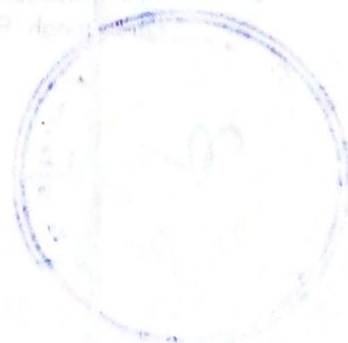

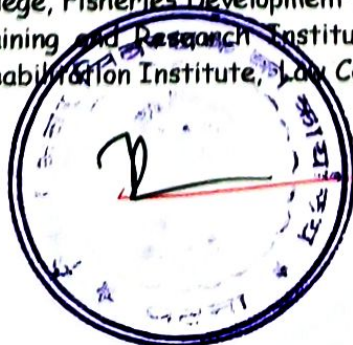

Hereinafter called the "Trustees" (Which expression shall wherever the context so admits or requires be deemed to include their survivors, heirs, executor's administrators, successors' legal representatives and assigns of the **Second Part**).

Whereas the Settler has decided to establish a Trust for furtherance of public charitable objects and for the purpose of giving effect to such desire, the Settler HAS MADE OVER A SUM OF Rs. 51000/- (Rs. Fifty one thousand only) to the Trustees by way of initial contribution and with intention that they shall hold the said sum, all gifts, contributions, subscriptions and donations for the said fund for public charitable purposes subject to trusts powers and provisions contained herein. The Trustees have agreed to become Trustees and to hold and apply the said sum for public charitable purposes.

**NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Name of the Trust: The Trust in hereby constituted as an irrevocable Trust and it shall more particularly know as "**RAMANAND EDUCATIONAL & WELFARE TRUST**". The Trustees may change the name of the Trust if they mutually so decide in future.
2. Registered Office:- M.I.G.-350, Lohia Nagar, Kankarbagh, Patna-20
3. **DECLARATION OF THE TRUST AND ITS OBJECTIVES.**  
The Trustees hereby declare that they and the survivor or survivors of them or other trustees hereof the time being will hold the said sum of Rs. 51000/- (Rs. Fifty one thousand only) made over by the settler to the Trustees as aforesaid and all gifts, contributions, subscription, donation, bequests and other moneys or properties as and when the same shall be paid to or invested in them and the moneys, investments and properties as from time to time representing the same upon Trust to apply the same for the benefit of poor and weaker sections of the society for improvement in their social, economic, cultural and environmental conditions and for their educational development and for the advancement of any other objects of their general utility (not involving the carrying on of any activity for profit) within the Bihar State. Theosophy observing the secular character of the nation and for such other purposes (without restricting the generality of the foregoing objects) to do all or any of the following.
  - I. To undertake projects, programmes, schemes, relating to health, and education such as Medical Hospital, Dental Hospital, Charitable Dispensaries, and Medical Aid Centres, Home for Women and Children, Maternity homes family welfare and birth control centre.
  - II. To establish, maintain, manage and administrator educational institution including professional and technical colleges such and institute of science and technology, polytechnic, Medical College and Hospital, Dental Colleges and Hospital, Institute of Management, Institute of Teacher Education Pharmacy College, Information Technology Institute, Computer Institute, Veterinary College, Agriculture College, Fisheries Development and Research Institute, Horticulture and Nursery Training and Research Institute, Nursing Training Centre, Physiotherapy and Rehabilitation Institute, Law College, for imparting technical and professional

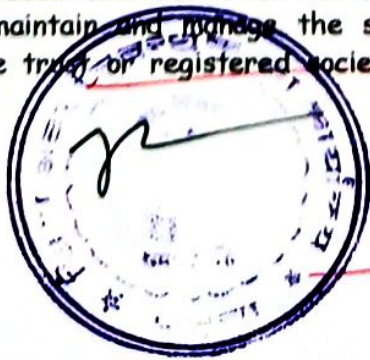

education to the deserving and needy youths of the society without any whatsoever discrimination whatsoever who after being trained at these institutions may get employment in their respective fields and thereafter may serve the society and contribute substantially to the development of the nation as worthy sons and daughters of the nation.

- III. To help, aid, assist, undertake, establish and maintain school including public school for boys or girls or for both and colleges for imparting, general, vocational industrial, physical, mental moral, education to deserving youth of the society without any discrimination whatsoever for advancement of their education, culture, language and art.
- IV. To establishment, run and maintain rest house, poor houses and any other such charitable institutions for the benefit of poor people of Bihar.
- V. To aid, assist and help deserving people of the community particularly in the rural and backward areas in connection with their personal, social and cultural needs including health, education, marriages and others.
- VI. To found, assist support, establish and maintain libraries and reading rooms, and to establish and maintain boarding house or hostel or assist such institutions.
- VII. To provide for endowments, stipends, scholarships, and other allowances to deserving and needy students.
- VIII. To open and maintain orphanages, widows homes and homes for blind and handicapped persons and provide them vocational and other trainings or to render assistance to any such existing institution or institutions.
- IX. To maintain, contribute or to give aid to any existing medical, technical, professional, professional educational or social institutions or any charitable institutions with philanthropic purposes which may be in the general interest of the poor of all castes of community and do all such acts and things with the objects of giving relief to the poor and backward people in general.
- X. To maintain, aid and assist the institution or institutions carrying out activities for national integration and preservation and strengthening of secular character of the Nation.
- XI. To do all such acts and things as may be conducive to the well being of the society in general and upliftment of educational and cultural conditions in particular.
- XII. To accept donations (in cash or kind) subscriptions, grants, presents and to collect dividends, rents, interest, and other income of the trust fund etc. for being utilized to further the object thereof.
- XIII. To undertake project, programmes and schemes for providing free formal and non-formal education to the poor and illiterate children belonging to urban slum areas, backward rural and tribal areas who for social or economic reasons are not attending schools.
- XIV. To undertake projects/schemes for providing minimum basis literacy skill to the illiterates through setting up adult education and non-formal education centres in urban slum, backward rural and tribal areas.
- XV. To take up schemes and projects for pollution control, health awareness and birth control family planning programmers.
- XVI. To take over with all its assets and liabilities or without previous liabilities and existing educational institution including professional and technical colleges and to own maintain and manage the same already lawfully established by any charitable trust or registered society having similar aim and objects if such

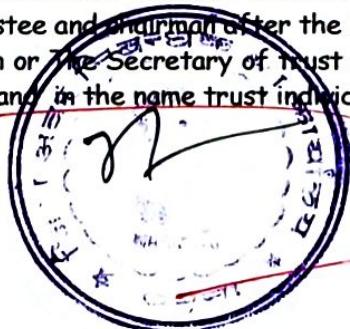


sponsoring body or the founder "Trust or society" is unable to run and manage the said existing institution., due to paucity of fund at their disposal or due to their other incapability if they request and offer to take over the said existing academic institution through unanimous resolution of their board of trustees or general body of the society as the case may be.

4. Management of the Trust:

The general management of the trust for the purpose of managing the affairs and properties and carrying out the object of the trust aforesaid shall be vested in the board of trustees. The board of trustees shall consist of chairman and Secretary. The chairman of the trust also will be the chief executive of the trust. The first chairman of the board of trustees shall be Mr. Rajiv Kumar who will hold office of the chairman and the chief executive officer of the trust till his life time. The first chairman of the trust Mr. Rajeev Kumar may nominate his successors in office and trustee-cum-next chairman of the trust. The next chairman of the trust so nominated shall enter into the office of the trustee and chairman of the trust only after the life time of the first chairman. If the first chairman fails to nominate his successor in office in that event after the life time of the first chairman, the trustees shall nominate one trustee to fill up the vacancy and shall also elect the next chairman of the trust for amongst themselves. The first Secretary of the trust shall be Dr. Sanjeev Kumar who will hold office of the trust till his life time. In case of vacancy the chairman of the trust will nominate next secretary of the trust. The secretary shall be custodian of all the records and proceeding books of the meeting of the board of trustees and he shall be responsible for the administration and general management of the affairs of the trust subject to approval of the board of trustees and he shall also be responsible for implementing the decisions/resolutions of the board of trustees. The secretary of the board of trustees shall prepare agenda, fix date, time and venue of the meeting. The chairman shall preside over the meetings of the board of trustee and shall sign the proceeding of every meeting of the board of trustees and without prejudice to the generality of the objects and powers above mentioned, the board of trustees shall have to do all or any of the following that is to say:

- i) To enter into contracts and borrow money from bank, institutions or individuals for the purpose of the trust and management of its properties and assets.
- ii) To appoint consultants for specific purposes on such terms and conditions as they may deem its.
- iii) To enter into agreement with organizations and individual for execution of any projects, that may be undertaken or taken over by the trust from time to time.
- iv) To make rules and regulation from time to time for the managements and conduct of the affairs of the trust and its properties and assets.
- v) The number of trustees shall seven. The trustees shall be trustees for their life time but, any trustee may resign by giving notice in writing to his co-trustees and shall also cease to be a trustee if requested in writing by three fourth of the remaining trustees or the number nearest thereto. Appointment of trustees, either to fill up a vacancy or as additional trustee, shall be by resolution of the trustees except the first chairman during his life time may nominate his successor trustee and the next chairman of the trust who will enter into the office of trustee and chairman after the life time of the first chairman.
- vi) The Chairman or The Secretary of trust can enter into any contract for sale or purchase of land in the name trust individually.

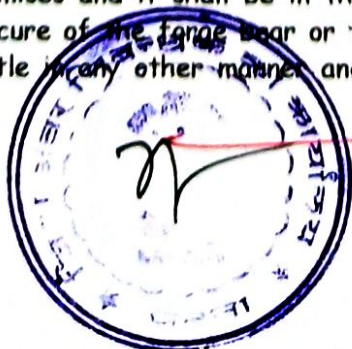

### Power of Trustees:

The trustees will also have the following powers:

- i) To apply the whole or part of the income or accumulation thereof or whole or part of the corpus of the trust properties for one or more of the objectives of the trust properties for one or more of the objectives of the trust as the trustees may from time to time determine.
- ii) To amalgamate the trust with any other trust or society for wholly public charitable purposes.
- iii) To convert and get in the trust properties and/or to vary the investment for the time being.
- iv) To invest and keep invested the trust properties in the purchase of immovable properties or in other assets specified in section 11(5) of the income tax act. 1961 and to alter vary and transpose such investment from time to time as the trustees shall in their absolute discretion, think fit. In any case the funds of the trust shall not be invested in any of the manner which is not permissible by relevant provisions of income tax act. 1961 applicable at any given time.
- v) The trustees shall have power to sell or assign any movable and immovable property or properties for the time being forming part of the trust fund either together or in parcels and either by public auction or private contract and either with or without any special or other stipulation as to title, evidence of commencement of title or other wise and to buy in an rescind or vary any contract for sell or to re-sell without being made answerable for the loss occasioned thereby and for the purposes aforesaid or any of them to execute and do all such assurances, acts, deeds and things as they shall think fit and out of the moneys which shall arise from any such sale for the interest and of the trusts or powers of these presents and shall stand possessed of the residue of the said moneys and also of the rents and profits of the said premises or of the unsold part thereof for the time being upon such trust and subject to such powers, provisions, agreements and declaration as are herein declared, provided. Always that the trustees shall manage any immovable property or properties for time being forming part of the trust fund in such manner as they shall think for with full power to make improvement, repairs or alternations of any description and to make or incur any outlay for any such purpose or for the insurance or otherwise for the protection or benefit of the said premises and to grant or renew leases of any description and upon any terms of the said premises or any of them or any part of part of parts thereof and to enter into any agreement or agreements or any descriptions for or in relation to the tenancy or occupation of the said premises or any of them or any part of parts thereof and to accept, surrenders of leases and agreements either in contemplation of a renewed lease of tenancy or occupation under the same respectively and to make any allowances to or agreements with tenants or occupiers or intending tenants or occupiers of the said premises and it shall be in the discretion of the trustees, either to procure of the large bear or to compound or submit to arbitration or settle in any other manner and if through fit altogether give up and

release any remedies or demands against tenants or occupiers or any other person or persons whomsoever in relation to the premises.

- vi) To invest, dispose off, transfer and otherwise deal with the subject matter of the trust in such manner as the trustees deem fit and proper to do carrying out the objects of the trust.
- vii) To open accounts with any bank or post office for the purpose of keeping the moneys of trust, to operate such accounts including overdraft accounts and to give instructions to the bank or post office and to provide for opening and operation of such accounts by single signature of any two office bearer's such as secretary or chairman.
- viii) To appoint, constituted attorney or agents and to delegate to such attorneys or agents all or any of the powers vested in them under these presents from time to time and remove such attorneys or agents and to appoint other or others in their place.
- ix) To make, vary, alter or modify schemes, rules and regulations for carrying out the objects of the trust and for the management of the affairs thereof and of running any institution in furtherance of the ~~objects~~ of the trust and otherwise for giving effect to the objects of the trust.
- x) To set part the whole or part of the income or the corpus or part thereof or any of the objects of the trust.
- xi) It shall be lawful of the trustees to settle and determine all matter of interpretations of these presents as well as all matter of difficulty, of doubt or dispute and all questions arising in the course of or incidental to and the administration, management and execution of the trust and power these presents and any such settlement of determination although the question involved may not have been actually raised shall be valid, binding and conclusive and shall be rejected to or re-opened upon any ground whatsoever.
- xii) To settle, ~~comprise or compound~~, out of court, all suits actions and other proceedings and to settle all differences and demands and to refer any or all such suits, actions or other proceedings, differences or demands to arbitration and to adjust and settle all accounts relating to the trust fund and execute release and to all things relating thereto as fully as if they were absolutely entitled to the trust fund and without being answerable for the loss occasion thereby.
- xiii) That trustee shall be entitled from time to time to appoint with or without remuneration and on such terms and conditions as they may think proper. ~~Persons or agents and to appoint committees~~ as they may think necessary to function under the authority and control of the trustees for carrying out the trust of these presents or the management thereof any may within the limits of their own powers invest them with all such powers including power to incur all such expenditures as may be necessary for carrying out the objects of the trust.
- xiv) The trustees shall be at the liberty to allow and permit any other trust, institution or charity in any local area or areas whose objects are the same or to areas whose objects are the same or to similar to those of these presents to be amalgamated with the trusts, created by these presents to the ~~intent~~ and effect that such other trust, institution or charity shall be deemed to be a part and parcel of the trust of these

presents, provided, that no conditions are accepted which involve a changes in the name of the trust or are insistent with or repugnant of the objects thereof.

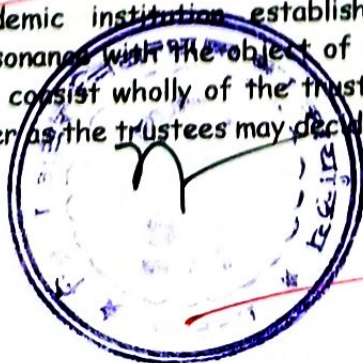
- xv) To pay all costs, charges, and expenses incidental to the managements, administration and execution of the trusts and powers herein contained.
- xvi) To purchase or hire or to take on lease lands, buildings and other immovable and movable properties in the name of the trust.
- xvii) To raise or borrow moneys required for the purpose of the trust on mortgage or pledge of the trust estate or any part thereof with or without any security and such rate of interest and on such terms as the trustees shall think fit.
- xviii) To do such act and things which may be incidental and necessary to attain the objectives of the trust?

6. Duties of the trustees:

- i) The trustees shall be chargeable only for such moneys, stocks, share and funds that shall actually come into their hands and shall not be answerable or accountable for neglect, default acts of omission or commission the other trustees nor of any bankers or other persons with who the trust properties of any securities may have been deposited or handed over unless caused by their willful neglect or default.
- ii) All the trustees shall be bound to maintain and defend all such suits, and (subject to provision of this deed) to take such other steps as may be reasonably requisite for the preservatives of the trust property and the assertion or protection of the title.
- iii) The trustees shall be bound to deal with the trust property as carefully as a man of ordinary prudence to deal with such property if it were their own. And in the absence of a contract to the contrary, a trustee so dealing shall not be responsible for the loss destruction or deterioration of the trust property.
- iv) If the trustee shall commit or threatens to commit any act which shall be destructive of permanently injurious to the trust property, the remaining trustees shall be bound to take measures to prevent such act.
- v) The trust shall be bound to keep clean and accurate accounts of the trust property at all reasonable times.

7. Rights of the Trustees:

- i) The trustees will not be entitled to receive any remuneration as trustees but may reimburse themselves of all expenses actually incurred by them in connection with trust or their duties relating thereto. The trustees may from time to time associate with the activities of trust any person or persons of public eminence as patron or patron-in-chief and may appoint or make provision for appointment of committee or managing committees for conduct of the affairs of the trust for the purpose of administration of any projects or scheme/s technical, professional academic institution established or undertaken by the trust in consonance with the object of the trust. The said managing committee may consist wholly of the trustees or partly of trustees and partly of other as the trustees may decide. The chairman of the trust shall be the

ex office chairman of such managing committee and he will call and preside over the meeting of the managing committee. The chairman of the trusts Mr. Rajiv Kumar will be the ex-office chairman of the managing committee of all the academic institutions whether general, technical or professional established and administered by the trust and the executive power to administer such academic institutions and to manage the day to day affairs of such institutions shall be vested in the chairman of the managing committee and he shall be the chief executive officer of the such managing committee.

ii) The trustees may from time to time frame schemes, rules, regulations, laws and bye-laws for regulating the affairs of the projects undertaken by the trust in pursuance to the various objects, such as rules as framed by the board of trustees for the conduct of affairs of the project shall be binding and no deviation shall be permissible in any of the rules so framed by any authority whatsoever connected with the said project without the prior approval of the board of trustees.

iii) a) The trustees shall have an advisory committee of national level to advise the trustees on the activities of the trust and to suggest how to make them better serves its aims and objects. The strength of the advisory committee shall not exceed 7 (seven) at a given time. The members of the advisory committee shall serve the trust in honorary capacity but they may be reimbursed such expenses as may be incurred by them for attending the meetings of the advisory committee, if so decided by the trustees.

b) Advisory committee appointed by board of trustees shall function under the direct control of the trust and the chairman of the board of trustees shall act as ex-office chairman of the said advisory committee.

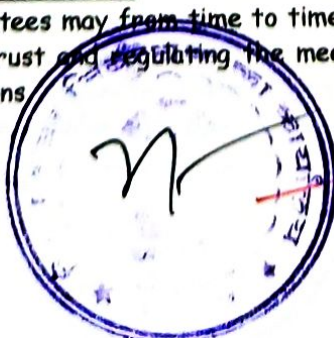
iv) The receipt of a person authorised by the trustees or a resolution of the board of trustees for any money paid or any property transferred or delivered to the trustees in execution of any of the trusts or powers thereof or for the purchase of any property authorised to be sold shall effectually discharge any person or persons so paying to transferring or delivering.

8. Indemnity to Trustees etc.:

The trustees for the time being of the presents shall be chargeable for only such moneys stocks, funds deposits and securities as they shall actually received not withstanding their signing of any receipt neglects, defaults and not for those of each other or any banker, suctioneer or any other person with whom or into whose hands any trust moneys or securities may be deposited or come in accordance with these present nor for the deterioration or loss of any stock, funds, deposits or securities nor for any other losses the same shall happen through their own willful default.

9. Rules of the Trust:

The trustees may from time to time form rules for the conduct of the affairs of the trust and regulating the meeting of the trustee in the absence of the regulations.

- i) All matters will be decided by majority and three trustees shall form a quorum for meeting of trustees provided however if the member of trustees fall below three of them for the purpose of appointing a trustees two will be a quorum.
- ii) Resolution passed without any meeting of the trustees and evidence in writing under the hands of three-fourth of the trustees or the number nearest thereto shall be as valid and effectual as resolution duly passed at the meeting of the trustees.
- iii) The existing Trustees may appoint one or more Trustees at their discretion from time to time, but in any cases, the total number of the Trustees to be appointed shall not exceed seven upon appointment of new Trustee or Trustees, the trust property shall be vested in the new Trustees jointly with continuing or surviving Trustees power and subject to this trust.

10. **RESTRICTION OR USE TRUST FUND AND DISPOSAL OF FUNDS ON DISSOLUTION**

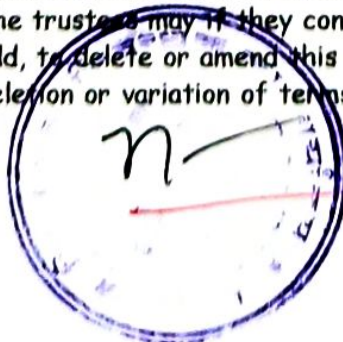
- i) It is expressly declared that no part of the Trust property or its income shall be applied for any purpose which is not a public charitable purpose in law and nothing herein shall be construed to authorise the Trustees to utilize the Trust assets or its income for its any non - charitable purpose. All the power and provisions hereof shall be constructed as being subject to the restrictions herein contained.
- ii) All activities financed from the fund shall be conducted in accordance with the ideas and objects as stated herein and no discrimination shall be permitted therein on grounds of religion, caste, creed or sex, provided that any donations earmarked and accepted for any specific purposes falling within the objects mentioned in THESE PRESENTS shall be for such specific purpose.

11. **ACCOUNTS AND AUDIT:**

The books of accounts of the trust shall be closed on 31st March, each year and after the closing, the statement of accounts in such form as the Board of Trustees may decide or determine will be prepared and thereafter the same shall be presented to the Auditors for report, as the Board of Trustees may appoint from year to year, and their remuneration will be decided accordingly in meeting.

12. **MEETING:**

- i) The meeting of the Board of Trustees shall held at least four times in a year but more number of meetings may be called if necessary. The meeting may be held at any place in Bihar State at the discretion of the Chairman of the Board.
- ii) A minute book shall be kept by the secretary wherein entry of all the proceedings of the meetings of the Board of Trustees shall be made which shall be signed by the Chairman of the meeting either at the conclusion thereof at the next meeting.
- iii) The trustees may if they consider necessary in the interest of trust to add, to delete or amend this declaration of Trust and on such addition, deletion or variation of terms contained in this deed by a resolution of

In case of difference of opinion arising among the Trustees and in all matters where the Trustees shall have the discretionary power, the opinion of majority as well as on those Trustees who may not have voted and if the Trustees are equally divided the matter shall be according to the casting vote of the Chairman.

- iv) All the power and provisions hereof provided in the Trust Deed shall be constructed as being subject to the restriction and limitations here in contained.

13. **ALLOWANCE TO TRUSTEES AND OFFICE BEARERS:**

If at any time any Trustee acts as whole time office bearer of the Trust of renders any special service, the trustees may at their discretion pay such remuneration or allowance to him as they may think proper.

14. **BOARD TO REIMBURSE:**

The trustees of these presents are entitled to be reimbursed and also to pay and discharge out of the Trust fund, all expenses incurred by them or on their behalf in or about the execution of the Trustees and power of these presents.

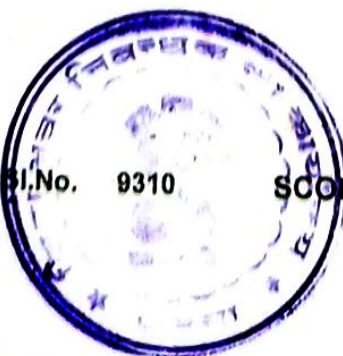
